

Thailand will grant visa exemption for nationals of 93 countries and territories including India. Thus, visa exemption for Indians has been extended beyond November 2024 till further notice.

The operations on these routes will commence on September 1, 2024 and the flights are now open for booking on the airline's mobile app and website, airindiaexpress.com and other major booking channels.





Vistara to offer complimentary Wi-Fi onboard international flights

Vistara now offers 20 minutes of complimentary Wi-Fi internet connectivity onboard international flights, operated using its Boeing 787-9 Dreamliner and Airbus A321neo aircraft, across all the three cabins. This service allows customers to receive one-time passwords via email, facilitating the purchase of extended in-flight Wi-Fi services during the active session.

Saudia ranks first worldwide in On-time Departure & Arrival performance

Saudia has topped the list of global airlines for on-time performance, according to a report by the independent aviation tracking site Cirium for June 2024. The report indicates that Saudia achieved an on-time arrival rate of 88.22% and an on-time departure rate of 88.73%, operating 16,133 flights across its network of over 100 destinations on four continents.





IndiGo enhances connectivity from Hyderabad and Ahmedabad

IndiGo has announced 10 daily direct flights to increase domestic connectivity from Hyderabad and Ahmedabad in September 2024. There are now daily direct flights between Hyderabad and Hirasar, from Sep 16. Hyderabad-Udaipur from Sep 1; Hyderabad-Jodhpur from Sep 3 and additional frequencies on Ahmedabad-Amritsar from Sep 16; Ahmedabad-Bhubaneswar from Sep 17.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh Dr Mohan Yadav will inaugurate the IATO Annual Convention on August 30, 2024 at Taj Lakefront as told by Principal Secretary Culture and Tourism and Managing Director Madhya Pradesh Tourism Board Shri Sheo Shekhar Shukla during the event at The Lalit, New Delhi. The theme of the convention is 'Resurgent India Inbound.'

The Ministry of Tourism, Government of India and many state tourism departments will participate in the convention. Rajendra Shukla Deputy Chief Minister and Jagdish Devda, Deputy Chief Minister, Shri Dharmendra Bhav Singh Lodhi Minister of State (Independent Charge) Culture, Tourism, Religious Trust and Endowment Madhya Pradesh will mark the event with their auspicious presence.
